



Week 5— Home Learning Menu —Year 1



Our theme this week is...

Spring!

Starters

Computing: Using a computer program such as 'Paint' draw a beautiful picture of Spring. How will you move the mouse to draw the picture? Which colours will you use to represent Spring? Can you give your picture a title?

Science: Go on a 'Spring Walk' and look for different signs of Spring. How is this season different from the others? Collect different items that remind you of Spring. Looking at the items— explore the different textures. How could you describe them?

Art: Using the items from your 'Spring Walk' create a 'Spring Collage'. Think about the different materials you could use to stick your items down. Don't forget to create a title and label the different items.

Main Course

Maths: Try some of the White Rose daily maths activities.

Look out of your window or stand in your front garden and count how many cars go past. How can you record how many cars go past? What is the most popular colour that passes? Choose a number between 10 and 20. How many ways can this number be partitioned? Do bigger numbers have more ways they can be partitioned?

English: Read the story of Jack and the Beanstalk (or watch on youtube). What makes the beanstalk grow?

Can you plant and make your own bean grow? Write a set of instructions of how to make a bean grow. Don't forget to include: a title, equipment needed, a method and remember to number the instructions. Also remember to use imperative verbs (bossy words!)

Can you illustrate your instructions with lovely pictures?

DT: Using junk modelling from around your house, create your very own 'Spring Garden'. Think about which materials would be best to use for grass or flowers. Can you add a gate that opens and closes?

Geography: Choose any country and research what the weather is like in Spring. Is it different or similar to England's? What other facts can you find out?

Listen to 'Solveig's Song' By Edvard Grieg. Create a dance that represents Spring. Think about how a bunny would hop or how to grow tall like flowers.

Think about how the music reminds you of Spring.

Speaking and Listening:

Play a Spring themed game of 'I Spy'. How can you describe the items? What questions can you ask to help you guess?
