Year 3: 'Meet the Brain', how our bodies work and some of the effects of cigarettes,

alcohol and medicine on your body.

Year 4: 'It's great to be me', starting to take control of our own choices and safety.

Year 5: 'Friends', the effects of drugs on the body, the influence of peers and the

importance of developing the skill of assertiveness

Year 6: 'Decisions', the effects of drugs and alcohol on the body, alternatives to drug

use and the role of peer influence.
