



Week 1- Home Learning Menu- EYFS



Our theme this week is...

Dragons!

<u>Starters</u>

Art: Draw a picture of a fantastic dragon! You can use paint or colouring pencils to add some colour to your dragon! Can you find any materials around the house to add to your dragon?

Once you have drawn your dragon— can you label it? Think about the key features... its wings or tail.

DT: Make a dragon out of junk materials you can find around your house. Can you make a part on your dragon move? What can you use to decorate your dragon?

Computing: Practice typing your name using a keyboard. Which key to do need to press to make the first letter a capital? Can you find the full stop?

Main Course

English: Watch Alphablocks (found on Cbeebies, YouTube, BBC iPlayer)- this will support your child with their letter sounds and with blending and segmenting words for reading and spelling.

Create a daily diary for your dragon— each day write a sentence or two about what your dragon has been up to.

Maths: Watch Numberblocks (found on Cbeebies, YouTube, BBC iPlayer)- particularly episodes with numbers up to 20, halving, doubling, more and less, counting in 2's, 5's, 10's. Look for ways to do practical addition and subtraction with items around the house. E.G. 6 apples add 4 oranges equals? Can you record your number sentences? Go on a shape hunt around the house— what 2D shapes can you find? What 3D shapes can you find?

Science: Will it sink or will it float?

Make a few boats out of different materials, such as paper, tin foil, playdough etc. Which ones will sink and which will float? Why do you think it happened?

Geography: Find out some facts about a capital city anywhere in the world. What special things do they like to do? Is this similar or different with the things you like doing?

Dessert

Speaking and Listening: Can you listen to story and then re-create the story?

Learn a song by heart— can you give a performance to your family?

Moving and Handling: How many star jumps can you do in 30 seconds? Try again, can you beat your score?

Travel around your house in different ways— can you balance on one leg?
