There is a separate presentation running at the same time for parents who have a child in Year 6 or Year 5 with an Education, Health and Care Plan for Special Educational Needs.


The Statutory Assessment Team will explain the application process for these children.

# **❖** SESSION 2: How to support your child with the move up from primary to secondary school

#### Presentation by an Educational Psychologist or Specialist Teacher

- Understand about building resilience and how this can help your child cope with the move up to secondary school
- Explore some possible strategies and techniques for you and your child to use as they move into Year 7

There will be two talks on this topic running at the same time. If your child receives support for Special Educational Needs you can choose to attend the talk aimed at helping these children.
