SECONDARY TRANSITIONS 2021 - NOW OPEN

All year 6 parents can now start to apply for a Secondary School for next September. You need to have done this by the 31st October 2020. It is vitally important you complete this online form as without it your child will not be allocated a school place for Year 7. You will receive your offer on the 2nd March 2021. If you have any issues, please let the office know and we will do what we can to help you.
