On the menu this term...

### Starters

**DT:** design and make a toy inspired by something from the past. It could be peg dolls, or a puppet, or something simple made from natural objects!

**History:** We are going to be learning about toys from the past. Ask your family for the rules to a game they played when they were little. Make a poster explaining the rules so others can play!

**Art:** Using natural things like stones, twigs, leaves and seeds make a piece of temporary artwork of your choice. Take a photograph of it and send it to school. Here are some ideas or search for an artist named Andy Goldsworthy

### Main Course

**English:**

Practise writing in full sentences by writing a record of an activity you have enjoyed doing out of school. It could be a club, a visit or something you have enjoyed doing with family or friends. Tell me why you enjoyed it so much!

**Maths**

We are looking at shapes in maths. Look for things around the house. How many different 2D shapes can you find? How many different 3D shapes? What is the most common shape that you can find? Record some of them and bring your findings into school.

**Science:** We are finding out about animals and humans! Make a plan for a new pet. What kind of animal is it? What kind of food will it need? Will it need a bed or a special house? What kind of special things will make it comfortable? Write a guide on how to look after it.

**Computing:** Practise writing your name on a keyboard (both your first and surname.) Can you put capital letters at the front of each part? Press Shift and the letter to make a capital. If you don't have a computer at home remember you can access then at your local library.

### Dessert

**Speaking and Listening:** To help the children gain confidence to speak in front of an audience, you could rehearse some sentences with your child to learn from memory that they could tell the class. It could be about one of their home work tasks!

**SMSC:** We are looking for photo's or written examples of when your child has displayed characteristics of effective learning. Please do send these in!
