



On the menu this term...

We are learning about vehicles as part of our topic work. Lots of these tasks are open ended so the work can be guided by your child's thoughts and ideas. You can support or extend them when needed.

Starters

Science: Create a timeline of photos to show how you have changed as you have got older. You could add labels or captions to describe the changes. Consider what you weren't able to do as a baby and when you learnt different skills (such as walking).

History: Research a mode of transport of your choice (for example: a hot air balloon, a steam train or a Lamborghini). Present your findings as you wish. You could create a labelled photo, a quiz or a PowerPoint.

Art: Create a piece of art inspired by a mode of transport. This could be a painting, model or sketch. Be creative!

Main Course

English: We're reading a story about a giraffe that travels around the world. Write your own 'around the world' story. Where will your character go? What problems might they face on their journey? Remember to practise each idea first and count the words before writing.

RE: Create a list of things that you are thankful for. Present this in a creative way. For example, you could write each idea on a colour strip of paper and make a paper chain of gratitude.

Maths: Carry out a survey. You could create a tally chart to find out how what coloured cars pass your house. You might draw a pictogram to show your friend's favourite colour. The choice is yours!

History: Design a vehicle from the future. What do you think it will look like? Will it have wheels or will it move in a different way? You might even want to make your design out of clay, junk modelling or Lego.

Dessert

Science: We're learning about how to keep healthy. Write or find a recipe for a healthy meal. You might even decide to cook your chosen recipe. If you do, bring in some photos of you cooking!

Reading: Think of a book that you've really enjoyed reading recently. Bring it in to share with the class. You could even create a poster to advertise it. Make sure you summarise the story.
