

Dear parents and carers,

It was so pleasing to hear that, as a country, we have been able to move into Step 3 of the Government's road map out of lockdown. These new freedoms, I know, will be warmly welcomed by us all and I hope that we are able to move into Step 4 in June.

Although restrictions have changed outside school – nothing changes for us within school. Whilst the Government open up life for us all personally, they have kept the majority of mitigations the same in schools. The only significant change was the removal of wearing face coverings at secondary school. So, this means that everything we have been doing all year here at The Grove is still in place. Please make sure that you continue to arrive at the correct time to drop off/collect your children so we can keep the number of adults on site to a minimum. We are very grateful that you all continue to socially distance from each other and leave site quickly. We would ask, though, that everyone moves away from the gate as this does cause a narrowing of the path for those wanting to get past.

We will be receiving more guidance around what needs to happen in school at the Prime Minister's next update which will be in mid-June. Currently, Cambridgeshire County Council have instructed us to continue with our risk assessment and mitigations until the end of this academic year. I will, of course, keep you informed of any changes we can make.

I am thrilled that Mr Johnson did clearly say that I can allow our Year 6 children to head off on their week away. I know that they, and the staff who are going with them, will have an amazing time. Miss Owen will be sending in daily updates, for us to send out here, and she will also post them on our Facebook page.

In the near future, I will be sending out a short survey to you all. As a staff team we are about to review the changes that we had to make due to the Covid 19 Pandemic. There are definitely some gains, which we may wish to keep, but there are also some losses which we will be glad to say goodbye to. I would like your views as well as part of this decision-making process.
