On the menu this week...

We have a range of projects and activities, some of which can be completed on the computer and others which can be completed with resources you will find at home. Have fun!

Starters

English & Science: Research a tree or plant of your choice. Make a fact file that tells us about how big it grows, where it is found naturally and what growing conditions it prefers. Draw and label its leaves, flowers and seeds. Find out how its seeds are dispersed.

D.T Make a healthy snack with your family. Write a list of ingredients, the method (how you made it) and what everyone thought of it.

Maths Keep working on learning your tables and the associated division facts! These are vital to your progress in maths and for life.

Maths:

Use a shopping receipt to practise some addition of money. Notice on the receipt how the numbers are lined up above each other in columns. Choose 2, 3 or 4 items from the list, set them out above each other, Estimate the total first (remember rounding will help here) and then find the total. Try a variety of different combinations and check your work. Was your estimate reasonable?

Science: Draw and label a house plant or other plant with these labels: leaves, stem, roots, petal, stamen, stigma.

Photosynthesis

Tell your family what photosynthesis is and why plants can do what humans and animals can't! Can you rememberwhat gas plants take in and which ones they give out? Why are trees and plants important for humans? Discuss with your family

Dessert

Art

Find some blossom or some spring flowers like daffodils and tulips.
Using crayons, pencil, paint, collage or felt pens carefully sketch, paint or collage what you see.

Speaking and Listening: Ask your family their favourite joke or find jokes in books or on the internet. Practise telling them to each other. Can you write your own?
