early for school tomorrow.”



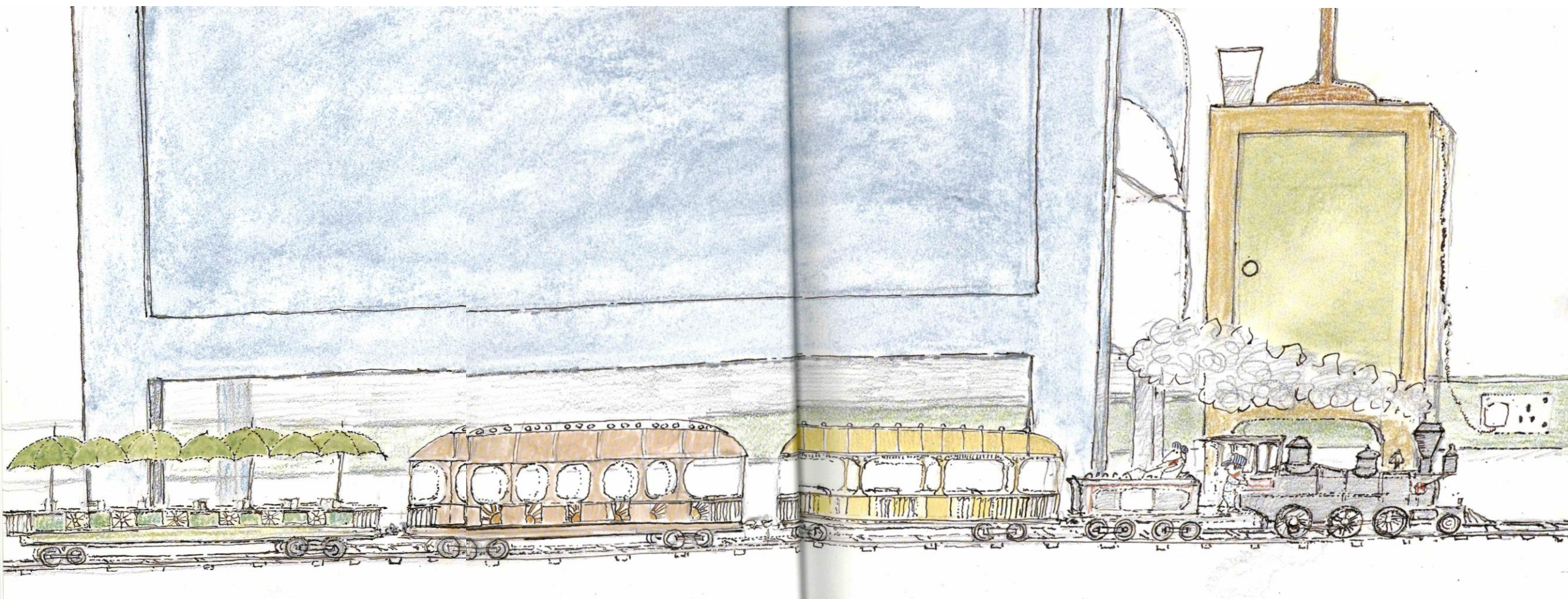
“Here is your pyjama-case dog. I found it under a cushion in the sitting room. Now, settle down and go to sleep.”











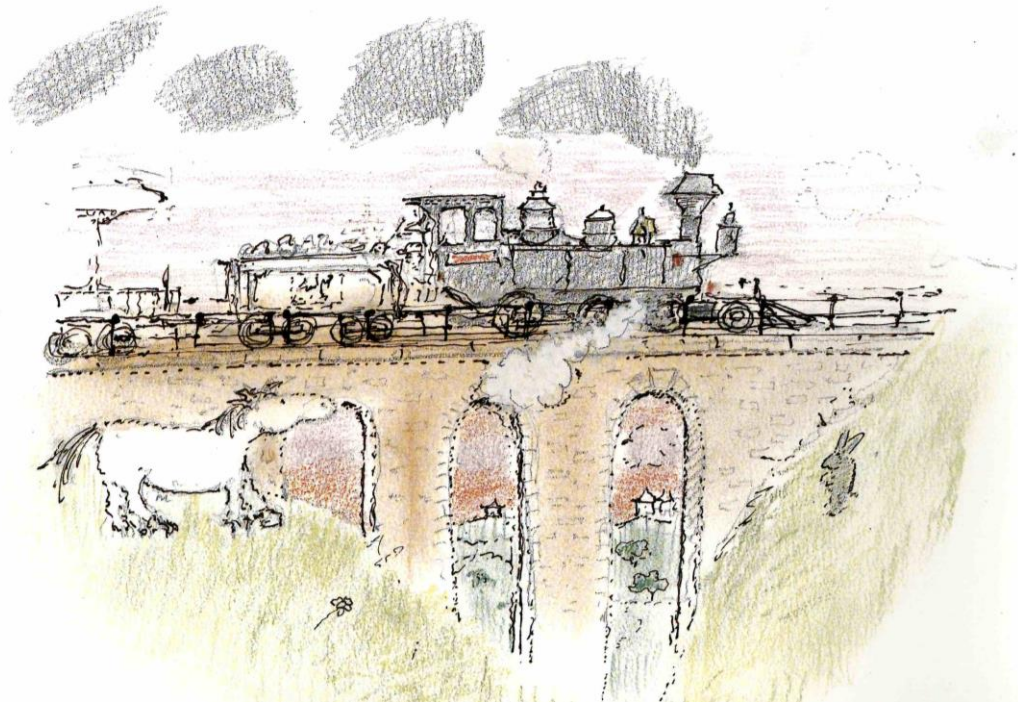


“We’re ready to go now.

If it is we must find somewhere for a swim.”





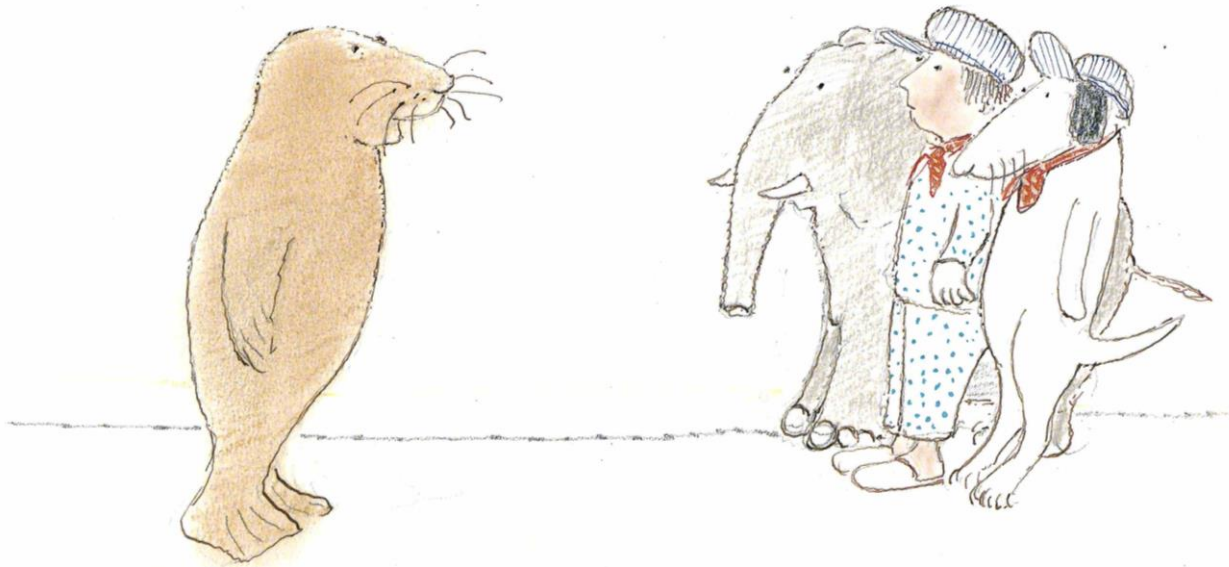


“Oi! Get off our train.”



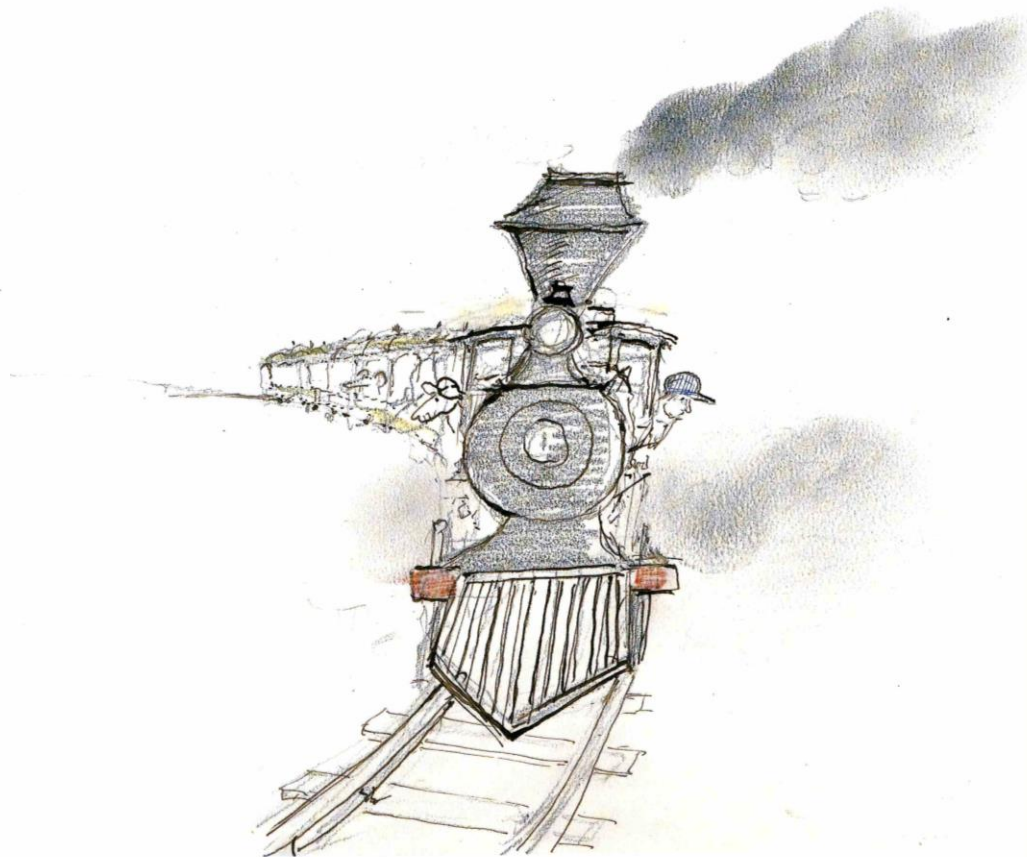


“Please let me come with you on your train.

If there is we can all fly kites.”





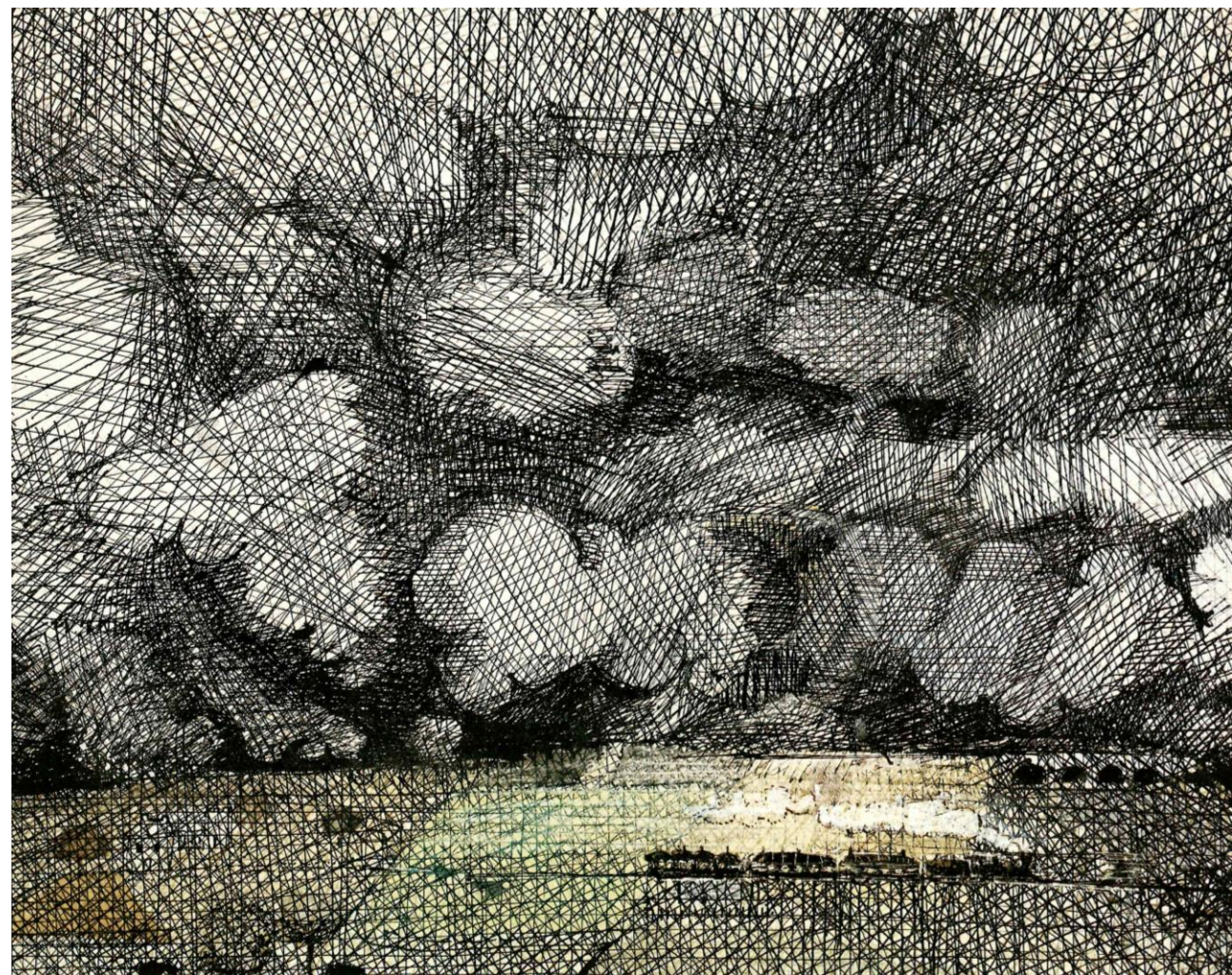
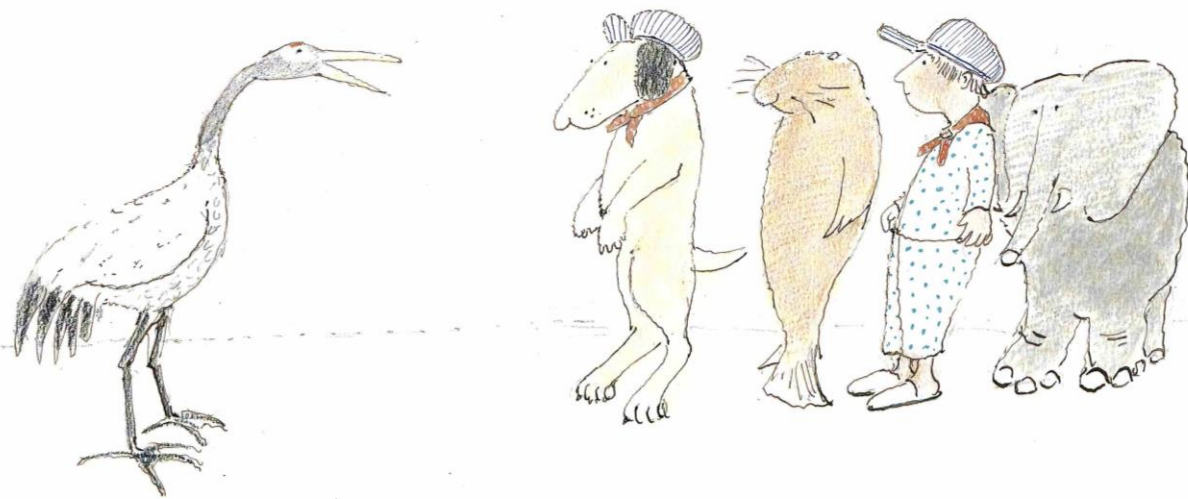


“Oi! Get off our train.”



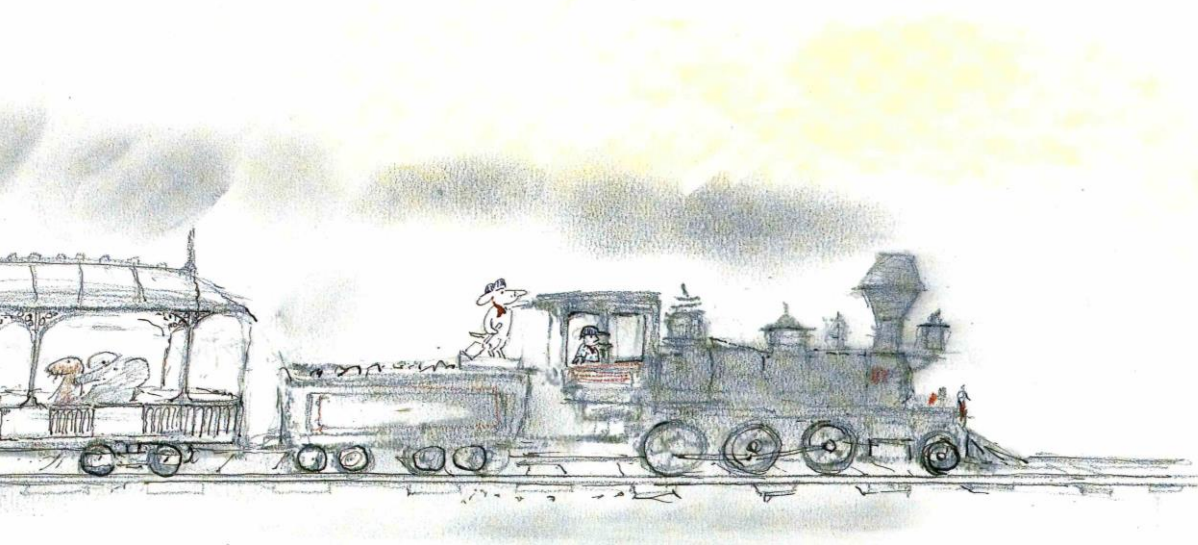


“Please let me come with you on your train.

If it does we can all muck about with umbrellas.”





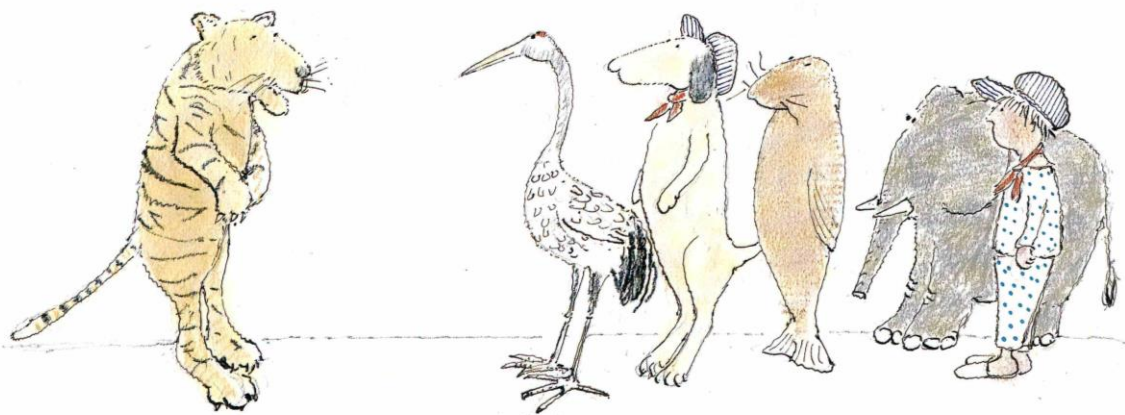


“Oi! Get off our train.”



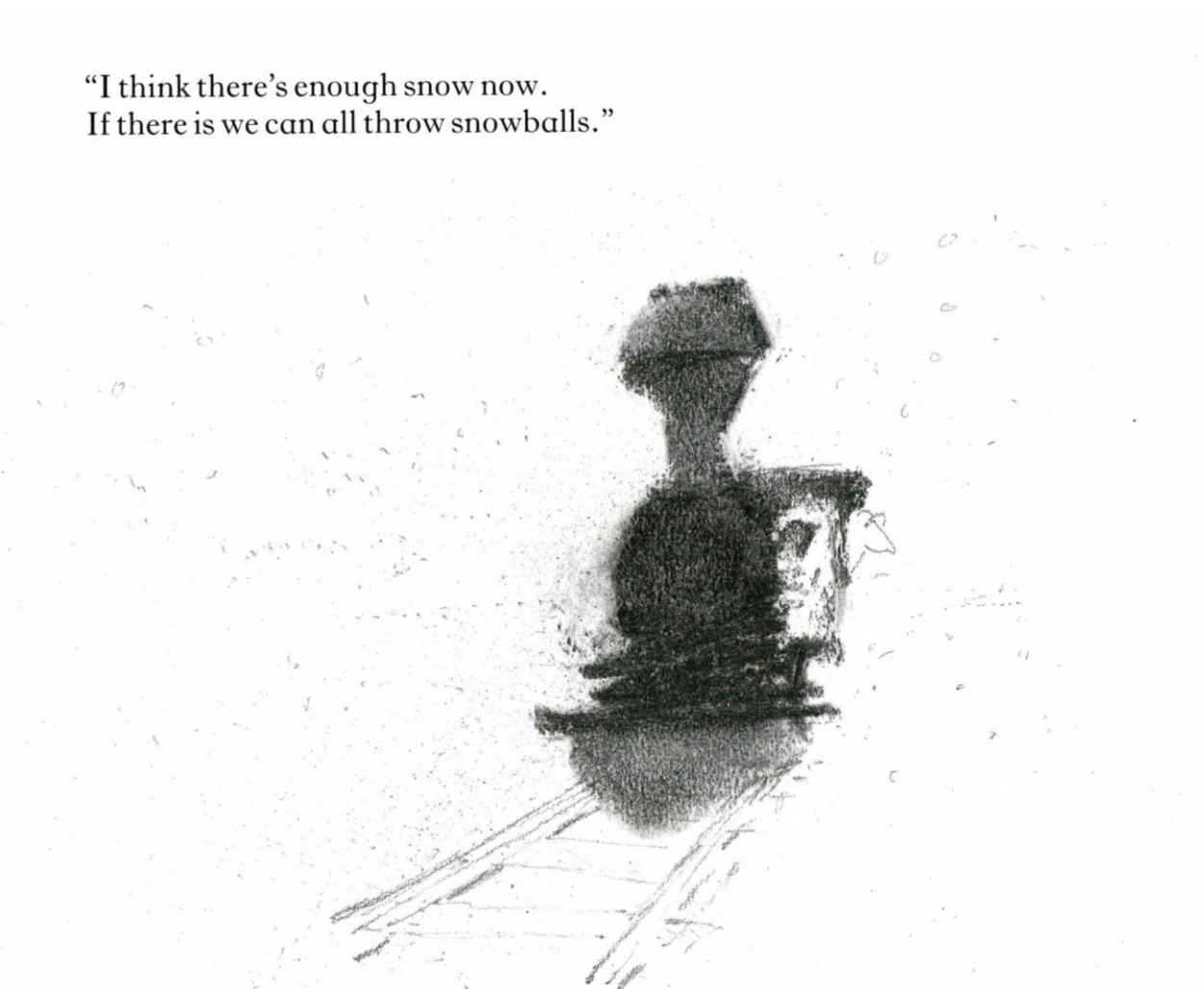


“Please let me come with you on your train.

and soon there will be none of us left."



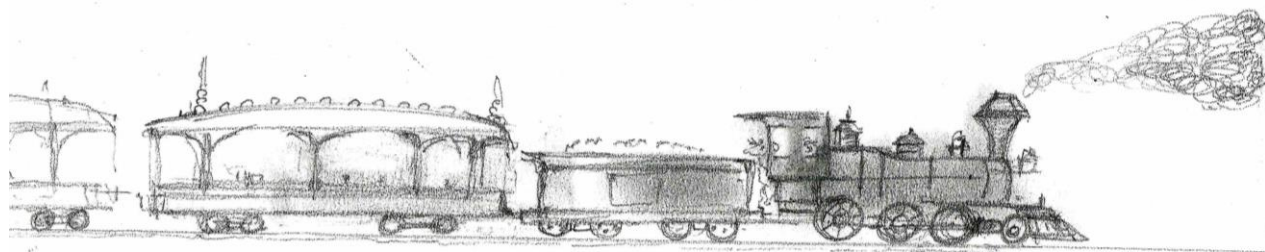
"If it does not stop snowing soon
