So, the Christmas festivities start! Today has been filled with Christmas music, glue and more glitter than I thought it was humanly possible to have. We have lots of wonderful things planned for December.

- Next week (W/c 30th November) we will be recording our Christmas Play ready to be published by the last week of the term. The whole school are involved in this and it replaces our usual Nativity and Carol Concerts.
- During the week starting the 14th December:

Monday 14 th December	Live (online) Pantomime from The Castle School in Cambridge. This is a professional company working with The Castle to put on a Panto. We can't wait to see what they have been up to!
Wednesday 16 th December	Christmas lunch for children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 (Gosling, Duckling, Wren, Ostrich and Flamingo Classes). You MUST book this vis SIMSPay, even if your child normally has a school lunch. The only school lunch option for children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 is a school packed lunch and again this MUST be booked in advance by Wednesday 2 nd December. Children are welcome to wear a Christmas Jumper to school.
Thursday 17 th December	Christmas lunch for children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 (Kiwi, Woodpecker, Kingfisher, Eagle and Kestrel Classes). You MUST book this vis SIMSPay, even if your child normally has a school lunch. The only school lunch option for children in Years R, 1 and 2 is a school packed lunch and again this MUST be booked in advance by Wednesday 2 nd December. Children are welcome to wear a Christmas Jumper to school.
Friday 18 th December	School finishes at: 2.00pm for Reception and Y1 2.10 for Years 2 and 3 2.15 for Years 4, 5 and 6. As we usually do at the end of the day, you can collect all your children at the same time. The Orchard will close at 4.15pm
Classes to choose time/date	We have a second, pre recorded panto bought for the children to watch. We bought this prior to The Castle advertising theirs and we wanted to support a local school.

A quick reminder about Christmas cards:

<u>Can the children bring in Christmas Cards to hand out?</u> Yes – we will have our post box up at the start of December. Cards can be brought in from Monday 7th December until Friday 11th December. The post box will then be put in quarantine for the weekend and Y5/6 will deliver the cards the following week. Please make sure that the name and class of the child that the card is for is on the front of the envelope or we will not be able to deliver them.

Finally, I would like to set a small competition for the children! I would like them to make a Christmas hat to wear on the day that they are having their Christmas lunch. There will be a prize for the most inventive hat in each class!
