Starters

DT: Make a medieval shield for a knight to use. This can be made out of any material, but must be fit for purpose, so it needs to protect your body and be held on your arm. Think about how you join the materials.

History: Step back in time and take a visit to a museum. Write a short fact file about one of the exhibits and what you learned about the past.

Art: Design a flag with your family crest. You will have to create this together, thinking of images that represents your own family and culture.

Main Course

English: Retell your favourite fairy tale with you as the main character. Draw a story map to show the main events and help you keep on track of the sequence of the story.

Maths: To learn the pairs of numbers that make 5, 10 or 20.
Practice counting to 20, 50 or beyond.

Computing: Use a paint program to draw a picture of a castle or palace.
