



Our theme this week is...

Pond Life

Starters

Computing:

Use google to find images of British ponds and pond life. What kinds of animals and plants like to be in ponds? Use the images to help you design and label your own pond—what would you like to live in it?

Science:

Explore the life cycle of a frog. What are the stages of a frogs life? Can you create your own lifecycle of a frog?

Make your own 3D frog appear in your home!

Is it different or the same to the lifecycle of a butterfly?

Learn to draw Oi Frog with the illustrator Jim Field! He has several other characters for you to try. You could try drawing your own character who could live in or near a pond.

Main Course

Maths: Try some of the White Rose daily maths activities.

Using a recipe, cook or bake something with your family that involves measuring. Talk about the measurements as you make it—what is the most you have to add? What is the least amount? What kind of measurements are you using?

English: Read the story of Oi Frog (or watch it on youtube!). What is frog's problem? Imagine you are frog, and you decide to send a letter to cat explaining that he is wrong. Why should frogs sit on logs? Where would you like to sit instead? Why do dogs have to sit on frogs? Is it fair that all these animals have to sit on things they rhyme with? You decide!

DT: Design and make a better seat for Oi Frog. How could you make it comfortable? How could you make it water proof? Don't forget to label the materials you will need!

Geography: In the UK we speak several different languages. What do you think are the biggest ones? Use the internet to find out! You can also use the [BBC bitesize website](https://www.bbc.com/bitesize) to learn a few words in some different modern languages. Can you learn how to say hello and thank you?
