



The Magic Toybox

On the menu this term...

Starters

DT: Make a home for a cuddly toy / doll or model. This can be made out of any material. How will you get the toy in and out? Think about how you join the materials. You could also decorate the toy home!

History: Step back in time and ask an adult you know about the toys they used to play with when they were younger. Draw or take or find a picture of it and label the toy or game. Why did they love to play with it?

Art: Design a family crest. You will have to create this together, thinking of images that represent your own family and culture.

Main Course

English: Draw and label your favourite toy. Describe the parts of the toy with how it looks or feels. E.g. soft brown fur. Tell us what makes it special to you and why it is your favourite!

Maths: Practise counting to 100 and beyond (and back)!
If your child is not ready for this, please just continue with counting to 10 or 20. Can they also count backwards starting at 10 or 20?
Notice and talk about numbers around us. Numbers are everywhere!

Science: Seasonal change. Think about and discuss the four seasons. What season are we in now? How does nature and weather change through the seasons? What is your favourite season?

Computing: Practise typing your name using the shift key to make a capital letter. If you don't have a computer at home, you can access these at your local library.

Speaking and Listening: To help the children gain confidence to speak in front of an audience, you could rehearse some sentences with your child to learn from memory that they could tell the class. It could be about one of their home work tasks!
