Main Course

In English, we are reading 'The Cloud Tea Monkeys' and our main writing outcomes will be to write a descriptive passage, a 'how to' guide, a letter, a discussion text, and lastly a non-chronological report. Perhaps, children could (with support and parental supervision) make and serve tea, once they have had the practical experience they could write their own instructions and illustrate it with diagrams or photos.

In Maths,
Revise and develop your knowledge of time and skills in telling the time. Revise units of time, how many seconds in a minute, how many minutes in an hour, quarter hour, half hour, three quarters of an hour etc.
Practise telling the time to 5 minutes, in analogue and digital time. Now practise 24 hour clock time -telling; if you add 12 hours to the digital time then you will have 24 hour clock time! Look on travel timetables (bus, train, aeroplanes) to see 24 hour clock times. How long are the journeys?

In Science, we are finding out about rocks. Do your own research project about a rock of your choice. It could be a precious stone like ruby or diamond or chalk, flint. Or limestone. In fact, choose any rocks you find interesting! Find out where in the world it is found, how it is used
