Dear Parents/Carers,

As schools we have a duty of care towards the welfare and safety of the children and adults at the school. During this challenging time it is really important to care and safeguard everyone.

Safeguarding means that:

- o children are protected from mistreatment
- o a child's health, or development, is protected
- o children grow up with safe and effective care
- o action is taken to ensure the best outcomes for all children.

Every child can potentially be hurt, put at risk from harm or abused regardless of their age, gender, religion, ethnicity or disability. Safeguarding is the action we take to promote the welfare of children in our care and to protect them from harm, we take this very seriously; it is everyone's responsibility to ensure children are free from harm and danger.

As we will not see many of our children for the foreseeable future, we would like you to know that there are several services available that can offer support to families. We have put a list together to make it easier for you to have the details available.
